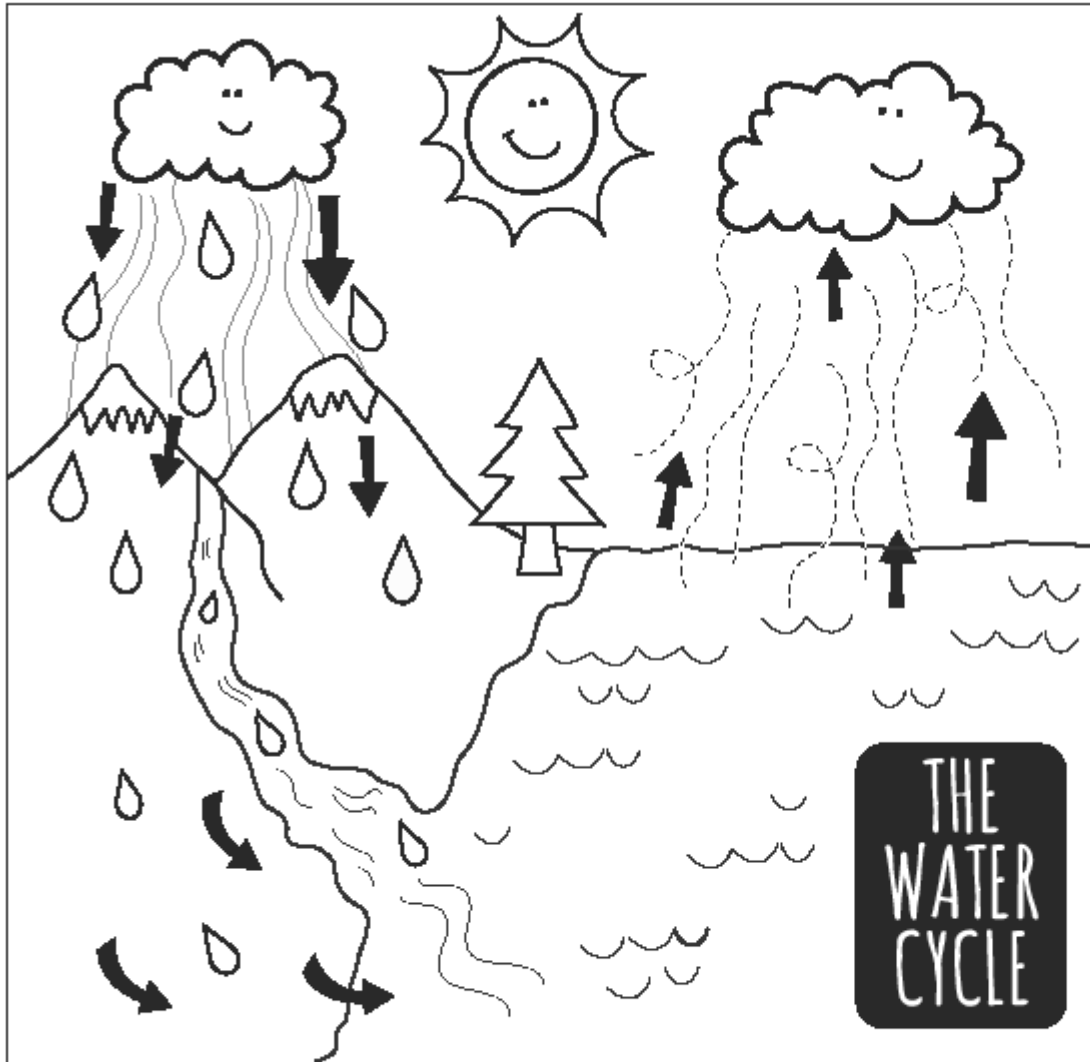

Water vapor is invisible in the air

WATER CYCLE DEFINITIONS

Accumulation/ Infiltration:

Water that seeps into the subsurface soil and rock.

Condensation:

The change of the physical state of matter from gas phase into liquid phase

Evaporation:

The process by which water changes from a liquid to a gas or vapor.

Evapotranspiration:

The sum of evaporation and transpiration.

Precipitation:

Precipitation is water released from clouds in the form of rain, freezing rain, sleet, snow or hail.

Surface Runoff:

The flow of water that occurs when excess water from rain, meltwater, or other sources flows over the earth's surface

Transpiration:

Water vapor that is released when plants "breathe" or the water evaporates from them.
